Elevation Capital Value Fund - 2018 Annual Report

This Annual Report covers the accounting period from 1 April 2017 to 31 March 2018 (Accounting Period).

Details of the Scheme

The name of the scheme is the Elevation Capital Managed Investments Schemes (Scheme). The type of scheme is an 'Other Managed Fund' (i.e. a managed fund which is not a KiwiSaver scheme, workplace savings scheme or superannuation scheme). The Scheme offers investment in one managed investment product, the Elevation Capital Value Fund (Fund). The Manager of the Scheme is Elevation Capital Management Limited. The supervisor of the Scheme is Public Trust.

The latest Product Disclosure Statement (PDS) for the Scheme is dated 7 December 2017 and is open for applications.

The latest fund update, dated 30 June 2018, was lodged with the Registrar on 11 July 2018.

The Scheme's latest financial statements and the auditor's report, for the year ended 31 March 2018, were dated 10 July 2018 and lodged with the Registrar on 10 July 2018.

Description of the Scheme

The Elevation Capital Value Fund mainly invests in listed companies, although it may invest in unlisted companies up to a total limit of 10% of Net Asset Value of the Fund. The companies we invest in may be based and operate anywhere in the world.

Information on Contributions and Scheme Participants

The number of managed investment products on issue at the start, and end of the Accounting Period was 1. The number of units on issue in the Fund at the start of the Accounting Period was 15,746,701 (01/04/2017). The number of units on issue in the Fund at the end of the Accounting Period was 19,652,957 (31/03/2018).

Changes relating to the Scheme

On 7 December 2017, the market index for the Fund changed from the MSCI ACWI Index (Gross Return) in NZD terms to the ACWI Value Index (Gross Return) in NZD terms to better benchmark the Fund with an appropriate market index having regard to our investing discipline.

There have been no other material changes to the nature or terms of the Scheme or Fund, the statement of investment policy and objectives, or the management of the Scheme over the Accounting Period.

Related Parties

General

Parties are considered to be related if one party has the ability to control the other party or exercise significant influence over the other party in making financial or operational decisions.

Elevation Capital Management Limited is the Manager of the Fund and The Public Trust is the Supervisor of the Fund. The New Zealand Guardian Trust Company Limited was previously the Trustee until 12 August 2016 when they were replaced by Public Trust. All are considered to be Related Parties.

CGS & CVS Limited (previously known as Elevation Capital Limited), a company controlled by Christopher Swasbrook, the Managing Director of the Manager, holds 57.57% (31 March 2017: 57.57%) of the issued share capital of the Manager.

Supervisor fees payable to The Public Trust are payable monthly in arrears. All balances are unsecured, settled in cash and do not attract interest.

ECML directors' interest, as well as related parties of directors' interest, in the Fund at balance date were 1,161,295 (31 March 2017: 1,024,408) units which represented 5.9% (31 March 2017: 6.5%) of unit holders' interest in the Fund.

The unit price for the Fund at the start of the Accounting Period was \$1.6212 (01/04/2017). The unit price for the Fund at the end of the Accounting Period was \$1.5123 (31/3/2018).
